

PET TRAVEL TO THE EU

INFORMATION REQUIRED FOR ANIMAL HEALTH CERTIFICATE COMPLETION

Client:

- title and full name (first and last) of the owner who will be signing the certificate
- complete postal address
- mobile telephone number

Pet:

- name
- breed
- sex
- neutered or entire
- colour
- date of birth
- microchip number

- *date and proof of microchipping* (if not done by us then we need to see EITHER an old pet passport OR a copy of the previous medical history showing the date of microchipping or that the microchip has been read at the time of a valid rabies vaccination)

- *date and proof of rabies vaccination* (if not done by us then we need to see EITHER an old pet passport with an in-date rabies vaccine OR a copy of the previous medical history showing the manufacturer/batch number/date of vaccine and that the microchip was read at the same time; please note that if certain other vaccines e.g. Lepto4 were given at the same time as the rabies vaccine, the rabies vaccine will not be valid)

Destination:

- country of entry into the EU
- date of entry into the EU
- other countries being visited during this trip
- date of return into the UK

On the day of AHC appointment:

- 20min duration
- pet needs to be present as the microchip needs to be checked on the day of signing
- this is NOT a health check - if the pet has a problem which needs addressing then a separate consultation needs to be booked (with their own vet or not our registered client; this includes fit to fly/fit to travel certification)
- the owner will have to sign the AHC, and it has to be the same person whose name is on the AHC (see Client section above)
- the AHC will be ready to collect the following day; if you need it the same day then an additional urgent completion fee of £100 applies
